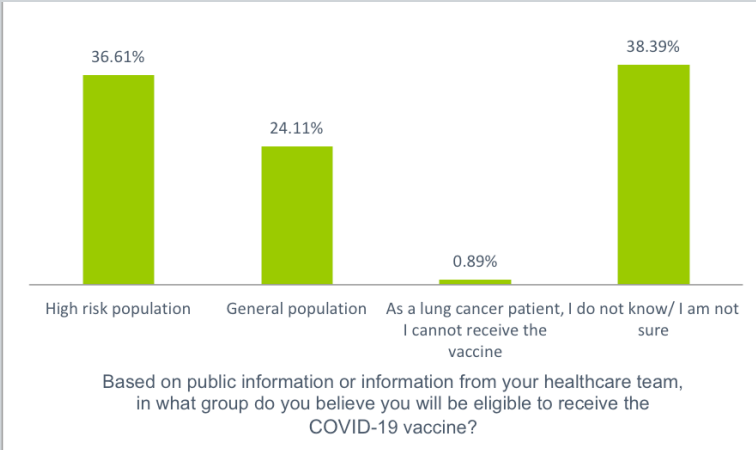

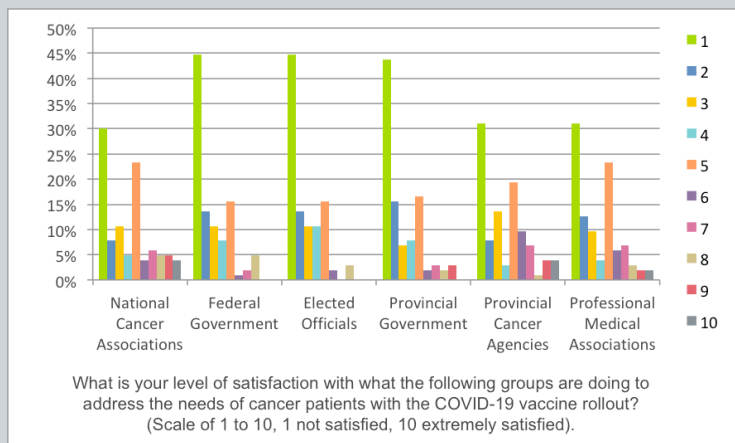
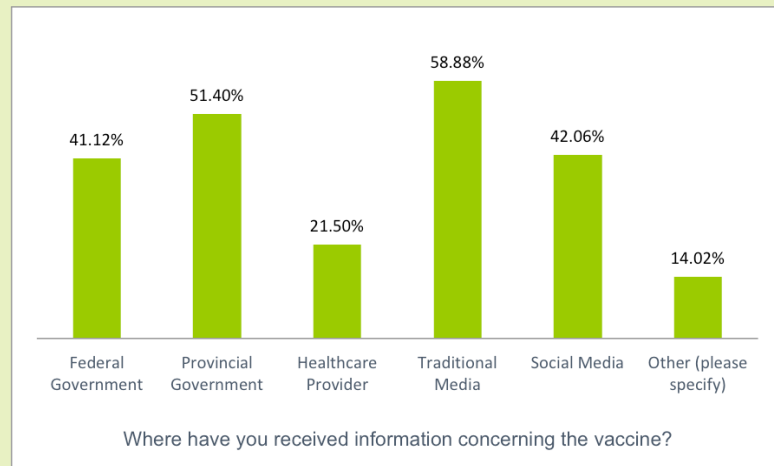

A survey was carried out by Lung Cancer Canada to determine the thoughts and feelings of lung cancer patients on the recently approved COVID-19 vaccine. It focused on areas of concern such as eligibility, prioritization and communication of information. The survey was fielded between February 11th and 16th, 2021 with 124 lung cancer patients across Canada responding to the survey. Here is what they told us:



92% of patients would receive the vaccine immediately if given. However, many don't know where they fall in terms of eligibility and prioritization.

Lung cancer patients want to know about the vaccine. The timely provision of information about the COVID-19 vaccine will help reduce uncertainties and anxieties.



Lung cancer patients felt they were not communicated with properly. They just want to know where they fall in the vaccination phases, and don't want to be forgotten.
